MATERIALS

Lunch-style paper bags

Sheets of Paper, slightly smaller than the paper bag

Hole Punch


Yarn or String

Pipe Cleaners- cut in half, the top folded over 1.5"


Decorative Materials

1. Fold paper bag and paper in half (hamburger-style).

2. Twist the pipe cleaner shut, creating a needle and run yarn yarn through needle's eye.



3. Punch 3 holes, about 1/2" from the spine of your papers. If the paper is too thick to punch them all together, punch one paper at a time, and use a marker to draw the holes onto the other papers and bag.


